However, the next part of this passage assures us of a bedrock truth about God.
- 2 God is faithful. God's faithfulness to us, like His faithfulness to the patriarchs, is a guarantee that God will finish what He started in us. Whatever God has called you to, He will see you through.

I'm so glad we serve a faithful God. As we continue on our journey with God, we can rest assured that His promises are truth and that He is faithful to finish what He started.
